Oxford is one of only a few graduate conferences in which student presentations are followed by responses from faculty members, making the conference a unique opportunity for students to get feedback on their work from Oxford faculty. - 2) The paper itself, including the title and a short abstract (no more than 200 words), and with no information identifying the author or the author's institutional affiliation.
